Hendry County – Wastewater Infrastructure on US27/SR80 – Phase Two

Talking Points:

Airglades WWTP

- Current Permitting Capacity of 30,000 gallons per day (gpd)

Future Growth

- Projected wastewater flow for Airglades is ~ 200,000 gpd at buildout
- The current Airglades WWTP is too small for the future development
- Nearby properties along US 27 have shown interest in developing (more flow)

Solution – Force Main to Clewiston WWTP

- Would extend from Airglades WWTP to Clewiston WWTP
- Would allow the Airglades WWTP to be decommissioned
- Would allow for development along US 27 to connect to Force Main
- Would eliminate septic tanks along corridor

Project Overview:

- Divert Flow at Existing Airglades Master Pump Station
- East side of Airglades Blvd. is free of utilities and potential conflicts
- County owned land provides opportunities for staging areas
- Existing collection system is sized appropriately
- Minor changes to existing pump station: i.e. pumps and electrical upgrades
- Preferred Route option is the berm south of the drainage ditch south of US 27/SR 80
- The property owners along preferred route have reacted positively to the use of their property contingent upon the County obtaining the required easements.
- Total decommissioning of the Airglades WWTP plant
