**JOB TITLES:** Paramedic (multiple positions available.)

**WORK LOCATION:** Assigned station in Hendry County, Florida

**PURPOSE OF JOB:** To provide both pre-hospital basic and advanced life support emergency medical care to the sick and injured on an ALS transport unit

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Responds to calls.
2. Assesses nature and extent of illness or injury to establish and prioritize medical procedures to be followed, or need for additional assistance.
3. Extricates trapped patient(s) and prepares them for transport to treatment center.
4. Provides safe and efficient transport.
5. Observes, records, and reports to physician the patient's condition and reaction to drugs, treatments, and significant incidents.
6. Communicates with hospital, physician, and other medical personnel in person and by radiotelephone.
7. Keeps current on treatment techniques, protocol changes, and application of new drugs, material, and equipment.
8. Prepares required reports and maintains records of activities.
9. Deals compassionately and reasonably with death.
10. Requests and restocks supplies, material, and equipment.
11. Cleans and performs minor maintenance to assigned emergency vehicle.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High School Diploma or related equivalent required.
- Current Florida Paramedic certification.
- Documentation of completion of 16-hour EVOC Course.
- Class E Florida Drivers License and have an acceptable driving Record.
- Satisfactory criminal background and employer reference checks.
