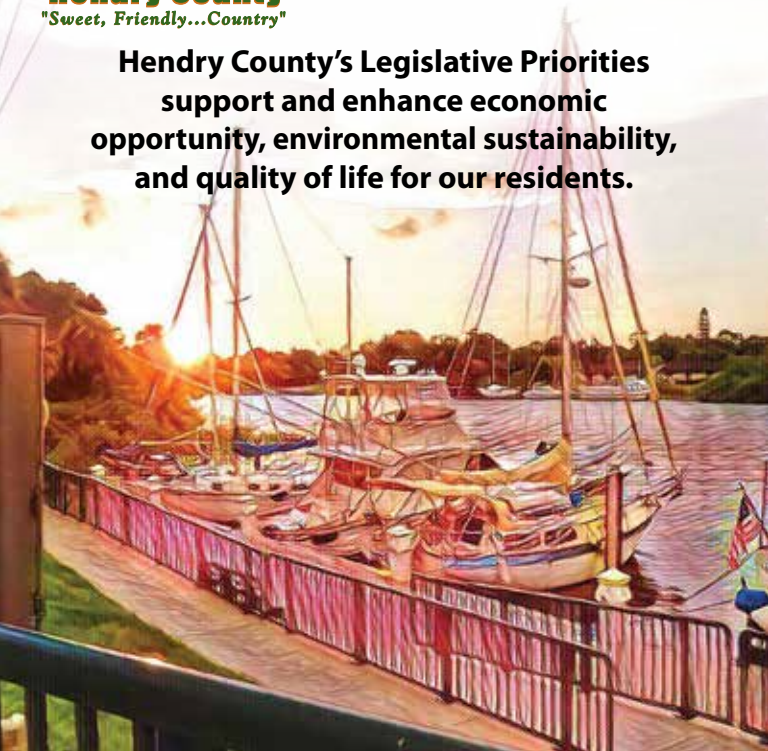

Water Quality & Infrastructure

Waste Water Infrastructure on US27/SR80 – Phase II
Funding for Phase II of the construction and construction engineering inspection services for the Waste Water Force Main from Airglades Airport to Clewiston Project. Phase I the due diligence and design phase of this project was funded in the 2015 Legislative session and is currently underway.

Four Corners Stormwater/Water Quality Project
Funding to construct the Shovel Ready storm water improvements in the Four Corners Area (Lee/Charlotte/Glades/Hendry Counties) to the County Line Ditch to reduce flooding and provide water quality.

Transportation

County Road 835
Fund the design, permitting, construction and construction engineering inspection services for CR835 from 21.6-miles south of US27 to 24.1-miles south of US27 (2.5 miles).

Hendry Isles Boulevard
Fund the design, permitting, construction and construction engineering inspection services for Hendry Isles Blvd from SR80 to Arcadia Avenue.

Ft. Denaud Bridge
Fund the rehabilitation of the historic Ft. Denaud Swing Bridge, a vital commuter route for residents in both Hendry and Glades Counties.
