Debris Clean Up In Hendry County

(September 21, 2017, 3:00 pm) LaBelle, FL – Contractors will begin picking up debris in Hendry County tomorrow, September 22, 2017.

Trucks will be running 7 days a week with multiple runs a day until all debris is removed.

Residents are asked to separate debris for more efficient pick up. Construction debris, horticulture and other miscellaneous debris may be picked up at different times.

MORE MANAGEABLE
 Follow these guidelines when putting out your debris to make for a speedier and less costly clean-up.

DO NOT STACK DEBRIS AGAINST
 Trees, poles, fire hydrants, and storm drains.

NO SIDEWALK
 If you do not have a sidewalk, place debris at the edge of your property before curb.

FOR MORE INFORMATION
 Contact your local town or city hall.

Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will not be picked up.
